News from the Silver Bug:

Greetings Fellow Silver Bugs, Collectors and Bullion Investors.

Radial Lines: In 2014, the Mint replaced the traditional bullion finish with radial lines, precisely machined to within microns. The uniqueness of the line width and pitch create a light-diffracting pattern that is specific to each coin.

Micro-Engraved Security Marks: Using the same award-winning technology found on Canada's \$ 1 and \$ 2 dollar coins, each bullion coin features a textured maple leaf, micro -engraved with laser technology and visible only under magnification. Etched within the maple leaf are two digits indicating the coin's production year.
